

Call to Order: Roxann Lewis, president, 12:00 pm

Invocation: Mary Blackwell

Veterans Day Recognition: A slide show to recognize veterans presented by Mary Blackwell. Recognition of veterans present by Roxann Lewis.

Loretta Roberts then asked for a vote from the membership. Board positions were approved

Announcements: Roxann Lewis introduced Jackie Irwin and Della Brown. They discussed their experiences at the TFRW convention.

Guest Speaker: Judge Mark Henry, Air Force veteran and 3rd term county judge spoke on many of the projects through his office. He began by speaking on the road and bridge projects and then moved to the question most addressed by his office, property assessments. He explained that the state is responsible for the assessment of local property and that his office is trying to make that a local responsibility. He then spoke about Veterans Court and their efforts to help veterans with addiction. He stated that success in the program is tied to accountability. He ended his talk with the redistricting map of which examples were on the back tables.

Programs for Veterans: Roxann Lewis introduced Jeff Picard who spoke on the wave program, Wounded American Veterans Experience Scuba. Then Natasha Picard spoke on the Yellow Ribbon Fund which is to support caregivers of Veterans.

Updates: Dr. Robin Armstrong, republican national committeeman, discussed the work that is being done to bring back the Republican House.

Kristen Day thanked all who donated their time, money and talents to the successful "Food for Thought" fundraiser.

Hospitality: The door prize was awarded.
