Richard Rennison, FBI Supervisory Agent

The Program for the May 3rd meeting of CCRW will feature law enforcement veteran, Richard Rennison. Richard is the Supervisory Special Agent at the Houston/Texas City FBI Office. His career in law enforcement started in League City in 1993 where he reached the rank of Detective. While at LCPD, Richard worked in Patrol, Criminal Investigations Division and Crimes against Children. He also worked with the Galveston County Narcotics Task Force.

In July 2003 Richard passed the stringent entrance requirements and was accepted into the FBI where he worked in a variety of divisions including Violent Crimes, Major Offender Cases and Crimes Against Children. Richard is a licensed pilot, an avid homebrewer of craft beer and enjoys time at the beach with his lovely wife and two teenage daughters.

6. click on *submit*.



