September Guest Speaker

Dr. Greg Bonnen,
Texas State Representative for District 24

Dr. Bonnen has resided in Galveston County for more than twenty years since attending UTMB in 1988. After finishing his medical education with high honors, Bonnen completed his residency in neurosurgery and served as assistant professor at UTMB before founding the Texas Brain and Spine Center. He also practices at Memorial Hermann Southeast. Dr. Bonnen has served over 13,000 patients in the Gulf Coast area and beyond.

In 2003, Dr. Bonnen and his partners founded Houston Physician's Hospital and began treating patients there in mid-2005. He has served as chairman of the board since 2006. Today, the Hospital provides a variety of acute and specialty care to communities throughout Southeast Texas and employs over 170 area residents. He also serves on the Board of Directors for Heritage Bank.

Dr. Bonnen has also volunteered his time, service, and talent with missions in Haiti, Cuba and the Philippines. He serves on the board and is President of the Medical Strategic Network.

Dr. Bonnen and his wife Kim live in Friendswood and have two daughters, Lindsay and Janae. They are active members of Friendswood Community Church.


