September Guest Speaker





Proposed 2019 Bylaw Changes

Article V- Officers and Executive Board

Section 5. Term of Office:

The term of office for officers and chairmen shall be from January 1 through December 31, or until their successors are elected, following their election or appointment, and no officer or chairman may serve in the same position for more than two consecutive terms with the exception of the PAC Treasurer and Treasurer.

Article VII - Nominations and Elections

Section 1. Nominating Committee:

A nominating committee of not less than three (3) and not more than seven (7), no more than two (2) of which shall be current member of the Executive Board, shall be elected by membership at the **September** meeting. The candidates for the Nominating Committee shall have been active members of Clear Creek Republican Women for not less than **one (1)** year. Members of the Nominating Committee shall be ineligible for nomination by the nominating committee. The Nominating Committee shall elect its chairman from one of its own number and shall report one nominee for each office at the September meeting. Nominees for Officers shall have been a full member of CCRW for at least one year. ~~The Nominating committee cannot succeed itself.~~

Article IX – Committees

Section 5. Finance Committee:

The President, First Vice President, Recording Secretary and Treasurer shall serve as members of this committee. The Treasurer shall serve as Chairman of the Finance Committee. The Finance Committee shall prepare a budget and present the same to the Executive Board and membership at the regular meeting in January. The Finance Committee shall perform such other duties as requested by the President and/or Executive Board.

Section 8. Proxy:

If a chairman of a standing committee cannot attend a board meeting, she may authorize another member of that committee to attend by proxy (form and signature must be provided).

ARTICLE XIII - CLEAR CREEK REPUBLIC WOMEN PAC Committee Guidelines For funding candidates

Section 1. Membership:

Membership is to consist of the following **seven (7)** members.

There will be **four** "standing" members consisting of the following:

- Current President of the Clear Creek Republican Women PAC;
- Campaign Activities Committee Chairman;

Immediate Past President:

PAC Treasurer of the Clear Creek Republican Women PAC;

Three (3) non-board members selected from the general membership by the President with the approval of the Executive Board.

Section 6: Donation Criteria:

The Donation Criteria for the Clear Creek Republican Women PAC shall be as follows:

Candidates must make request for funds in writing to the Clear Creek Republican Women PAC within thirty (30) days after completion of the primary election, including any runoffs. Candidates shall be notified of required request for funds immediately after the primary election.
