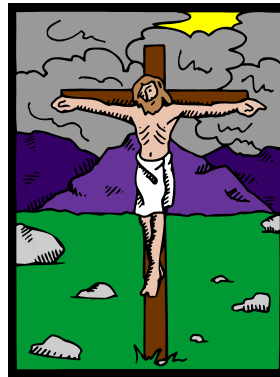


Run Off Election
