Book Review

The Proper Care and Feeding of Husbands

Men and women are different. Obvious to many, but not to Time Magazine, which carried a cover story in July 1995 on the differences in the way men and women think¹.

Unfortunately, the feminist battle cry has been that men and women are the same (as opposed to endowed with the same rights and responsibilities). Over time, this has led to the feminization and degradation of the male of our species.

Dr. Laura Schlessinger's book, <u>The Proper Care and Feeding of Husbands</u>, seeks to remedy the brainwashing that has taken place for a generation. To many, Dr. Laura's common sense advice might seem just that, common. In light of the media onslaught of negative male stereotypes (is there a TV dad who is not a loser?), Dr. Laura's words need to be read.

Her formula for successful relationships, happy families, and a better life is simple: mutual respect, recognition of differences, and the placement of value on male and female roles. To many, especially the last point signals the subjugation of women, which is not the point.

Dr. Laura demonstrates, through witty commentary and anecdotes from callers to her radio show, that men and women have separate, important roles in society. Without the protector, defender, breadwinner role of the male, the nurturing, caring, community-building role of the female is made more difficult.

She points out that men actually *do* have feelings that matter, they need to be told they are important, and that we should all be grateful for their positives, rather than calling out (and trying to change) the negatives. She also builds up the role of the family as the most important unit in society. It's not about individuals going through life on vaguely similar paths – the happier we make our families, the happier we will all be in the long run. This was a surprisingly informative book, was easy to read, and provided a lot of good food for thought. I highly recommend it.
