

Mínutes from August 1st, 2008

Candidate Spotlight on: Justice Phil Johnson Texas Supreme Court





Justice Johnson was appointed to the Court on March 15, 2005, by Governor Rick Perry. He was serving as Chief Justice of the Seventh Court of Appeals in Amarillo at the time of his appointment. In November, 2006 he was elected to fill the remaining two years of the Supreme Court

term to which he was appointed. Justice Johnson will run in 2008 for a full six year term. He serves on the Court in Place 8.

Justice Johnson attended Texas Tech University School of Law, where he was a member of the law review and graduated with honors in 1975. He has been named as a Distinguished Alumnus of the Tech Law School.

Justice Johnson has been active in church, civic, and professional organizations. He has served on many boards and committees including Boy Scouts of America, Kiwanis, Lighthouse for the Blind, Trinity Christian Schools and the Carillon Foundation. He is member of the College of the State Bar and is a life fellow of both the Texas and American Bar Foundations.

From 1965 until 1972 he served in the U.S. Air Force as a pilot and instructor pilot, and was honorably discharged as a captain. He is a decorated veteran of Vietnam. Justice Johnson is married to Carla Jean Johnson and has five children.
