Team Leads were introduced and highlighted their areas of expertise and department duties. Sheriff Fullen said he sits right on the first floor at his desk and invited people to come down and see him.

Karen Bubrig from the Law Enforcement Alliance, a 501c3 whose mission is to provide supplemental funding for Law Enforcement agencies in Galveston County to cover things that are not in their budgets, discussed their fundraiser April 5th Bullets Bags and Bingo Kentucky Derby




